



The Ipsen award

Ipsen and the Endocrine Nurses' Society of Australasia are pleased to announce the 2010 Ipsen award. This award offers a number of places for ENSA members to attend the Endocrine Society of Australia's Clinical Weekend, to be held 27–29 August 2010 at the Crown Plaza Terrigal Resort, New South Wales. The Ipsen award covers economy airfare (if applicable), conference bus connection, registration and accommodation.

Aim

The purpose of the award is to encourage and enable nurses specialising in the field of endocrinology to increase and update their clinical knowledge and to engage with other clinicians working within the speciality.

Eligibility criteria

Applicants must:

1. be a registered nurse in Australia or New Zealand working within the nursing speciality of endocrinology
2. have a minimum three years' experience in the nursing profession
3. be members of ENSA (applications for the Ipsen award accompanied by an application for membership may be considered).

Members who have not received an Ipsen award within the past 24 months are encouraged to apply.

Selection

The successful applicants may be required to write an article about the clinical weekend for the next ENSA newsletter or to produce a poster or give an oral presentation at the 'Nurses in Action' session at the ENSA meeting in the following year. The successful applicants and the task they will be required to complete, as part of the award, will be decided by the conference committee, who will notify the applicants in writing.

Applications

Applications should include:

- a current curriculum vitae
- a covering letter stating how useful attendance at the weekend would be to the applicant.
